Getting to and from Kolding

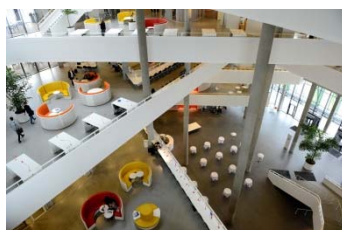
The closest airport is Billund Airport, situated 45 kilometers from Kolding. Buses for Kolding leave the airport approx once an hour arriving just beside the train station in Kolding (see timetable at the airport's website). It is also possible to arrive at Copenhagen Airport and then go by train to Kolding (takes approx 3 hours). The university lies 5-10 minutes of walk from Kolding train station.
